APPLICATION FOR CONSENT UNDER SECTION 36 OF THE ELECTRICITY ACT 1989 FOR THE GENERATION OF UP TO 20MW OF ELECTRICITY FROM THE EXISTING EUROPEAN MARINE ENERGY CENTRE'S WAVE TEST SITE AT BILLIA CROO, ORKNEY.

Thank you for your comments on the application for consent under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 submitted by The European Marine Energy Centre Ltd (EMEC) on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019. EMEC have addressed the comments and hereby resubmits formal application for consent to generate up to 20MW of electricity at its existing grid-connected wave test site, Billia Croo. The consent period requested is to 2040.

Established in 2003, EMEC is the first and only centre of its kind in the world providing clients of both wave and tidal energy systems with purpose-built, accredited open-sea testing facilities. EMEC's grid-connected wave test site is located at Billia Croo, off the west coast of Orkney Mainland. This consent application has been submitted as a proposed change to the existing licensing arrangements for clients wishing to access EMEC's Billia Croo test site.
